APPLICATION & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any high school senior, who is a son or daughter of a Tucson Utility Contractors Association member or an employee of a member and will be enrolling full-time in an academic institution for their first collegiate year.

HOW WILL THE APPLICATION BE JUDGED?

Selections will be based on the general worthiness of the application. The scholarship judges will consider: (1) Scholastic standing, (2) ACT and/or SAT scores (not required for students applying for a two year award), (3) Extra curricular activities, (4) Career goals, (5) Past employment, (6) Essay written by candidate, and (7) Community service. *Thoroughness of the completed application will have a bearing on the scoring by the judges.*

HOW WILL THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF THE APPLICATION BE PROTECTED?

When the application is received by the Educational Scholarship Foundation of the Tucson Utility Contractors Association, each application will be numbered. Once this has been completed, the first page of the application will be placed in a sealed envelope marked only with the number of the applicant. The Scholarship judges will review the applications with no knowledge of the applicants' name, address or any other revealing information. Once the selection has been made, only the winning envelope will be opened to identify the award recipient.

HOW DO I APPLY?

All applicants complete the application forms in accordance with instructions and send to the Educational Scholarship Foundation of the Tucson Utility Contractors Association 1842 West Grant Road, Suite 103, Tucson, AZ 85745.

WHAT MUST ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION?

1. A current transcript of high school grades.
2. A letter of recommendation from a member of the high school faculty. The letter should include the number of students in the graduating class and the class standing of the applicant.

Incomplete application will not be considered for awards.

WHEN MUST I APPLY?

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE POST MARKED NO LATER THEN **MAY 1ST, 2010**. The award winner will be notified **June 1, 2010**. SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABLE HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR

4-year, college or university scholarship, \$8,000 over 4 years (\$2000 a year).

The scholarship applications, as received, are numbered and screened so that the copies going to the scholarship judges will give no knowledge of the applicant's name or other revealing information. Each judge studies all the applicants, scoring them in accordance with the guidelines stated in "HOW WILL THE APPLICATION BE JUDGED?" The scoring of each applicant by each judge is done preparatory to the panel of judges meeting to determine the recipients of the available scholarships. Scholarship awardees, to receive the financial award in the following year(s), must supply the Educational Foundation with proof of credit hours completed during the year, current registration for the coming term, social security number, and current address. This is to comply with IRS regulations.
